Praise God that I have five Bible studies so far this semester. I co-teach the advanced class on Sunday mornings which means that I have Amy, Ally, and Sandy back in my class. We are watching and discussing the "That the World May Know" VCDs. Praise God that Ally indicated that she is now a Christian. On Monday afternoons, I have a Bible study with seven students who are also in one of my Bible characters classes. I have another six students in my Bible study on Tuesday mornings. Both Bible studies will be studying four discussion books which have been quite successful for me over the past two years (three out of four professions have come from people studying these books). Jannie and Fiownna (saved last year) are meeting with me on Thursday mornings. Pray that they will be faithful and grow in their faith. We are studying some "How to" books. Finally, on Thursday nights, I have a Bible study with a new believer Esther (depression problems) and a seeker named Molly. We are studying the basics of Christianity. God is definitely speaking to Molly as she came with a question that was dealt with in the first chapter of the book.

Classes are going pretty well, but keeping me busy. Also, English Student Council has been having some internal conflicts. Pray for agreement and mutual respect. Pray also that everyone will do their jobs correctly as that is part of the problem.

My counseling class (each teacher has a class which he or she is responsible to counsel or advise on their academic and personal problems) is responsible for the last Friday chapel before Christmas. Pray that we can do a drama that will really bring out the meaning of Christmas.

Praise God that I have finished my Greek class and also that I was able to visit everyone I wanted to visit in the U.S. except Amanda (a student who arrived in the Washington, D.C. area a few days before I left).
